Any person convicted of violating subparagraphs 6 or 7 is guilty of a misdemeanor.

CHAPTER 65—S. F. No. 209

An act relating to highway traffic regulations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 169.201, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 169.201, as amended by Laws 1959, Chapter 521, Section 4, is amended to read:

169.201 **Yield sign.** The driver of a vehicle approaching a **YIELD RIGHT OF WAY** sign shall slow to a speed that is reasonable for conditions of traffic and visibility, and stop if necessary, and yield the right of way to any pedestrian legally crossing the roadway on which he is driving, and to all vehicles on the ~~intersection~~ *intersecting* street or highway which are so close as to constitute an immediate hazard.

CHAPTER 66—S. F. No. 302

An act authorizing the extension of Laws 1957, Chapter 644.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Wild life development, extension of program.** The provisions of Laws 1957, Chapter 644, Sections 1 to 4 appearing in Minnesota Statutes 1957 as Sections 97.481 to 97.484 inclusive, shall continue in effect until December 31,

CHAPTER 67—H. F. No. 177

An act relating to services for the blind; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 248.07, Subdivision 12.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 248.07, Subdivision 12, is amended to read:

Subd. 12. **Reimbursement, out of state distribution of Braille and talking books.** The commissioner of public welfare shall obtain reimbursement from other states for the estimated cost of handling of *Braille books and talking books* for the blind distributed by the department of public welfare to users in such other states and may contract with the appropriate authorities of such states to effect such reimbursement. All money received hereunder shall be paid to the state treasurer and placed in the general revenue fund.

CHAPTER 68—H. F. No. 310

[Coded in Part]

An act relating to municipal courts; fixing the salary of the judge of municipal court of Waterville.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Waterville, municipal judge.** The annual salary of the judge of the municipal court of Waterville is \$900, retroactive to January 1, 1961, notwithstanding the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 691, Section 1, Subdivision 2.

Sec. 2. [482.26] **Waterville municipal court.** The revisor of statutes in compiling the next edition of the Minnesota Statutes shall substitute the salary fixed in section 1
