

CHAPTER 9—H. F. No. 302

An act appropriating additional moneys to the revisor of statutes for bill drafting and related services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Revisor of Statutes, appropriation.** The additional sum of \$30,000 is appropriated from any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated to the revisor of statutes for bill drafting and related legislative services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961.

Sec. 2. **Effective date.** This act is in effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 10—H. F. No. 50

An act authorizing the conveyance of certain real estate owned by the state to the city of Winona.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **State land, transfer to Winona.** The governor, upon the recommendation of the state college board, shall transfer and convey by quitclaim deed, in such form as the attorney general may approve, in the name of the state of Minnesota, to the city of Winona, without consideration, the following described property located in Winona county, Minnesota, to-wit:

Commencing at the northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section Twenty-Eight (28), Township One Hundred Seven (107), North of Range Seven (7) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, thence running south on the section line between Sections Twenty-Seven and Twenty-Eight (27 and 28) of said Township and Range a distance of 330 feet to an iron monument, which said monument is located 2 feet south from the north face of the stone wall and on the south right of way of Lake Boulevard, thence northwesterly along the south right of
