An act relating to courts and authorizing the employment of law clerks for judges of the district court in and for the county of Hennepin; amending the title to and certain provisions of Laws 1955, Chapter 321.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The title to Laws 1955, Chapter 321, is amended to read: An act relating to courts and ~~judicial employees; authorizing certain counties to employ the employment of~~ law clerks for judges of the district court in and for the county of Hennepin.

Sec. 2. Laws 1955, Chapter 321, is amended to read:

Section 1. **District court; Hennepin county; law clerks.**
~~Subdivision 1.~~ The judges of the district court in ~~any district containing a city with a population in excess of 500,000 according to the 1950 census and for the county of Hennepin~~ may employ a law clerk to assist them in the performance of their duties. *The law clerk shall assist the judge who is in charge of the special term calendar, and shall work under his immediate supervision and direction.*

~~Subd. 2. The law clerk shall assist the judge who is in charge of the special term calendar, and shall work under his immediate supervision and direction.~~

Sec. 2. Subdivision 1. The law clerk shall be paid not more than ~~\$4,800~~ \$5,200 in any one year by and in the same manner as are other county employees of the county in which the city referred to in section 1 is located, and at a rate established by the district judges of the district in which he is employed ~~court in and for the county of Hennepin.~~

Subd. 2. The law clerk may be removed from office at any time without cause for any reason by the judges of the ~~said~~ district court ~~for the district in which he is employed.~~

Sec. 3. *This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the county of Hennepin and upon compliance with the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 368.*
