The commissioner shall thereupon order and direct a surcharge to be collected of two percent of the fire, lightning, and sprinkler leakage gross premiums, less return premiums, on all direct business received by any foreign or domestic fire insurance company on property in this city of the first class, or by its agents for it, in cash or otherwise, until the balance in the special fund of the relief association amounts to *a figure arrived at by multiplying the population of the city according to the latest federal census by one dollar and eighty-seven cents per inhabitant or to \$600,000, whichever is the larger*, and for a period of 15 days thereafter. As soon as the balance in this special fund amounts to *a figure arrived at by multiplying the population of the city according to the latest federal census by one dollar and eighty-seven cents per inhabitant or to \$600,000, whichever is the larger*, the board of trustees of the relief association shall certify that fact to the commissioner, who shall forthwith issue his order directing that the collection of the surcharge be discontinued after the expiration of the 15-day period and forthwith mail a copy of this order to each insurance company affected thereby. This surcharge shall be due and payable from these companies to the state treasurer, in semiannual installments, on June 30th and December 31st of each calendar year, and if not paid within 30 days after these dates, a penalty of ten percent shall accrue thereon and thereafter this sum and penalty shall draw interest at the rate of one percent per month until paid.

CHAPTER 22—H. F. No. 99

An act relating to the salaries of the county auditor and county treasurer of Murray county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Murray county, auditor's and treasurer's salary. Subdivision 1. The county board of Murray county may fix the salary of the county auditor and the county treasurer of the county of Murray so that each shall receive an amount not to exceed \$6950 per annum, and that the salary so

determined shall be retroactive to the date of January 1, 1961.

Subd. 2. Said county auditor and county treasurer shall be included under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 375.43, and acts amendatory thereof.

Subd. 3. Nothing contained in this act shall be construed as limiting the right of such officers to collect and retain fees, per diem payments, or any other payment which they are now authorized to collect in addition to the stated amount of their yearly salary.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective upon approval by a majority vote of the governing body of the county of Murray, and upon compliance with Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

CHAPTER 23—H. F. No. 101

An act authorizing the issuance of bonds by independent school district No. 316 (Coleraine), Minnesota, and the levy of taxes for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Independent school district No. 316; bonds.** Independent School District No. 316, state of Minnesota, situated in Itasca county and including within its corporate limits the village of Coleraine and other territory, is hereby authorized to issue not to exceed \$200,000 of its negotiable coupon general obligation bonds for the purpose of retiring certificates of indebtedness or interest thereon issued in the year 1961 under Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 471.75, Subdivision 4. Such bonds shall be authorized by a resolution of the school board adopted by a favorable vote of not less than two-thirds of its members elect, and shall be sold and issued in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1957, Sections 475.54 through 475.57 and 475.60 through 475.74 in such amounts and at such times during the year 1961 as may be determined by the school board without approval of the electors being required for their issuance.
