An act relating to highways; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 162.14, by adding a new subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 162.14, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

[Subd. 6.] Highways; state-aid system; advances. Any such city, except cities of the first class, village, or borough may make advances from any funds available to it for the purpose of expediting the construction, reconstruction, improvement, or maintenance of its municipal state-aid street system; provided that such advances shall not exceed 40 percent of its last apportionment. Advances made by any such city, village, or borough shall be repaid out of subsequent apportionments made to such city, village, or borough in accordance with the commissioner's rules and regulations.

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 263.01 is amended to read:
