CHAPTER 626—H. F. No. 635

An act relating to work relief program in St. Louis county; providing for assignment to other political subdivisions; amending Laws 1961, Chapter 316, by adding new sections thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1961, Chapter 316, is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 4. St. Louis county; work relief program. The county may contract with the federal government, or with any department, agency, subdivision, or instrumentality of the state, or with any political subdivision within the county, for the services of such work relief recipients on such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon, with or without consideration paid to the county.

Sec. 2. This act shall not become effective until after its approval by a majority vote of the county welfare board and a majority vote of the St. Louis county board, and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 627—H. F. No. 671

An act relating to highway traffic regulations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 169.18, Subdivision 9.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 169.18, Subdivision 9, is amended to read:

Subd. 9. Traffic regulations; divided highways; crossovers. Whenever any highway has been divided into two or more roadways by leaving an intervening space or by a physical barrier or clearly indicated dividing section so constructed as to impede vehicular traffic, ~~or by a double center line~~; every vehicle shall be driven only
