be for use in connection with the present armory in the village of Long Prairie.

CHAPTER 17—H. F. No. 75 [Not Coded]

An act authorizing the conveyance of certain real estate owned by the state to the county of Clearwater.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Conveyance of state owned land; Clearwater county. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the governor upon recommendation of the commissioner of highways shall transfer and convey in the name of and in behalf of the state of Minnesota by quit claim deed, upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon, to the county of Clearwater, for park purposes, the following described real estate situated in Clearwater county, Minnesota, to wit:

All or part of the following described tract:

Government Lot 2 (SE ¼ SW ¼) of section 13, township 144 north, range 37 west;

which lies southwesterly of a line run parallel with and distant 100 feet southwesterly of the following described line:

Beginning at a point on the westerly boundary of the southwest quarter (SW½) of said section 13, distant 683.2 feet southerly of the northwest corner thereof; thence run southeasterly at an angle of 61°56′ with said westerly boundary for 120.0 feet; thence deflect to the left on a 0°45′ curve (delta angle 7°12′) for 960.0 feet; thence on a tangent to said curve for 767.0 feet; thence deflect to the right on a 1°00 curve (delta angle 21°30′) for 2150.0 feet and there terminating;

containing 18.47 acres, more or less.
