CHAPTER 190-S. F. No. 893

An act relating to game and fish, authorizing the commissioner of conservation to prescribe by order the taking and possession of salmon from inland lakes or international waters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [101.50] Salmon, seasons and limits. The commissioner of conservation is hereby authorized to prescribe by order seasons and limits and the manner of taking and possession of salmon from inland lakes or international waters.

CHAPTER 191—S. F. No. 897

An act realting to game and fish, authorizing the commissioner to apply fish toxicants to waters of the state for the purpose of reclamation; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 97.48, Subdivision 16.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 97.48, Subdivision 16, is amended to read:

Subd. 16. Fish; toxicants. The commissioner shall rescue, transfer, or otherwise dispose of or sell fish found in waters, which by reason of their shallowness, will endanger such fish to smothering in winter, or by published order, or in cases of emergency by notice posted conspicuously around the shores upon any such waters, to authorize the taking of fish in any quantity and in any manner, except with the use of seines, hoop nets, fyke nets, or explosives, by residents of the state of Minnesota, for personal use only, except that bullheads and rough fish may be sold. The above provisions shall also apply to waters in which fish toxicants will be used for purpose of reclamation.
