

act, provided any balance remaining on June 30, 1962, shall not cancel but be available for the succeeding fiscal year until the project authorized is completed. The moneys from the trunk highway fund shall be expended solely for the purpose of repairing or rebuilding culverts or bridges on trunk highways required pursuant to sections 1 and 2. The plans therefor are to be approved by the commissioner of highways.

CHAPTER 197—H. F. No. 254

An act relating to the state employees retirement association, providing for certain optional annuity payments to surviving spouses of members; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 352.28, by adding a new subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 352.28, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

Subd. 8. State employees retirement; optional annuities. *If (a) a member and his spouse are both at least 64 years of age when, in accordance with section 352.64, he files with the association his application for joint and survivor optional annuity providing for payments thereunder to his surviving spouse; and (b) such application is filed with the association at least 40 days prior to the member's death; and (c) the member's death occurs less than 15 days before the first optional annuity payment would have accrued to him had he lived; then, upon fulfillment of these conditions, his surviving spouse shall be entitled to the survivor's optional annuity specified for her benefit thereunder, to accrue from and after the day following the last day for which the member was paid salary.*
