An act providing that villages and towns shall constitute separate election districts in the metropolitan area as defined by Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 473.02, Subdivision 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [203.061] Elections; metropolitan area districts. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary each village and each town located within the metropolitan area as defined in Minnesota Statutes, Section 473.02, Subdivision 5, shall constitute a separate election district.

## CHAPTER 235-H. F. No. 789

[Coded in Part]

An act relating to municipal courts; fixing the salary of the judge of municipal court of Wayzata.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Wayzata municipal court; judge's salary. The annual salary of the judge of the municipal court of Wayzata is \$3,600, effective January 1, 1963, notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 488.21, Subdivision 2.
- Sec. 2. The revisor of statutes in compiling the next edition of the Minnesota Statutes shall substitute the salary fixed in section 1 hereof for the salary specified for such judge in Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 488.21, Subdivision 2.
