CHAPTER 243—S. F. No. 1125

An act relating to Anoka county; authorizing a tax levy for library buildings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Anoka county; library building tax levy.** The county board of Anoka county may levy a tax of not more than one mill on the dollar of all taxable property in the area within the county served by the county library system for the purposes of constructing library buildings and branches thereof. The levy of such tax shall not cause the amount of other taxes levied or to be levied by Anoka county, which are subject to any limitation, to be reduced in any amount whatsoever.

Sec. 2. Section 1 is effective upon its approval by a majority of the members of the county board of Anoka county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 244—S. F. No. 305

An act relating to the county state-aid system; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 162.08, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 162.08, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

162.08 Subdivision 1. **County state-aid highways; allocation.** When the commissioner has determined the sum of money to be apportioned to each county as hereinbefore provided, he shall

allocate a percentage of such sum for expenditure solely on those portions of each county's county state-aid highways located within cities, villages, and boroughs having a population of less than 5,000, according to the last federal decennial census; *or, if incorporated during the ten-year period between federal decennial censuses, according to their incorporation census.* The percentage so allocated shall equal the percentage that the total needs of the county state-aid highway system in such cities, villages, and boroughs bears to the total county state-aid highway needs in each county. Money so allocated shall be set apart and credited to the municipal account of each county.

CHAPTER 245—H. F. No. 333

An act relating to public waters and the dumping of trash; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 616.163, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 616.163, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

616.163 **Trash, dumping into public waters or on ice.** Subdivision 1. No person shall throw, dump or deposit or cause or permit to be thrown, dumped or deposited in any lake, stream, river, or any body of public water, or on the ice thereof, or on the lands adjacent thereto without the consent of the owners of such land, any trash, rubbish, garbage or other litter. *Without limiting the generality hereof, trash, rubbish and garbage shall include cans, bottles, fuel oil, ashes, chemicals, and waste food products.*
