in this chapter shall authorize any person, association, or corporation to engage, in any manner, directly or indirectly, in the practice of dentistry as defined by law.

- Sec. 19. [159.39] Provisions severable. The various provisions of this act shall be severable and if any part or provisions shall be held to be invalid, it shall not be held to invalidate any other part or provisions thereof.
- Sec. 20. [159.40] Effect of act. This act is not to be construed as to repeal any existing law. Nothing contained herein shall deny the right of licensed dentists to provide dental care under any form of organization that is now or hereafter recognized under the laws of this state, or to contract to sell their services in any manner that is now or hereafter may become lawful under the laws of this state.

An act relating to the village of Arden Hills; authorizing the sale of food in "on sale," or combination liquor stores; amending Extra Session Laws 1961, Chapter 53, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Extra Session Laws 1961, Chapter 53, Section 1, is amended to read:
- Section 1. Arden Hills, village of; liquor stores. Any establishment in the village of Arden Hills in Ramsey county which holds an "on sale" or a combination "on sale" and "off sale" license for the sale of intoxicating liquor may sell food.
- Sec. 2. Effective date. This act is effective upon its approval by a majority of the members of the governing body of the village of Arden Hills and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 645.021.
