

Sec. 4. The officials named in section 1 shall appoint deputies and clerks in accordance with law, and the county board shall appropriate funds for payment of salaries of deputies and clerk hire.

Sec. 5. The county board shall provide for payment of premiums of any bonds required of any official designated in section 1 or any employee of such official.

Sec. 6. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the members of the board of county commissioners of Dakota county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 324—H. F. No. 1128

An act relating to Olmsted county; authorizing the county welfare board to pay certain salaries and expenses of assistant county attorney.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Olmsted county; welfare board; assistant county attorney.** The county welfare board of Olmsted county is authorized to pay from welfare funds a share of the salary, clerk hire, and expenses of an assistant county attorney, such share to be proportionate to the expenses incurred on county welfare board matters and other county matters as determined by the county attorney.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the members of the board of county commissioners and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
