

## CHAPTER 37—S. F. No. 233

*An act relating to contracts in Anoka county.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Anoka county; bids upon tax supported projects.** In Anoka County, no contract for the purchase of supplies, materials, or equipment, and no contract for work or labor or for the construction or repair of buildings, roads, bridges, or other permanent improvements, the estimated cost or value of which shall exceed \$2,500, shall be made by the county board, commission, or agency having charge of any activity supported, in whole or in part, by taxes upon the taxable property of Anoka county without first advertising for sealed bids which shall be solicited by public notice inserted at least once in the official newspaper of the county at least ten calendar days before the final date of submitting bids. All bids shall be opened in public at a specified time and place and shall be read aloud and tabulated. All such contracts shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder, shall be duly executed in writing, and the person to whom the same is awarded shall give sufficient bond for its faithful performance, and it shall be approved by resolution of the board or commission and signed by its chairman. In case no satisfactory bid is received the board or commission may readvertise. Every contract made without compliance with the provision of this subdivision shall be void; provided, that in case of an emergency arising from the breaking, damaging, or decay of any Anoka county property, that cannot be allowed to wait for the time required to advertise for bids as herein required, and where the public health and safety would suffer by the delay, contracts for the purchase or repair may be made without advertising for bids.

**Sec. 2.** This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the members of the board of county commissioners of the county of Anoka, and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
