CHAPTER 466—S. F. No. 1335 [Coded]

An act relating to wild animals; permitting the commissioner of conservation to issue licenses without cost to take fish to wards of the commissioner of public welfare; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 98.47, by adding a new subdivision thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 98.47, is amended by adding a new subdivision thereto to read:

Subd. 13. Fishing; institutionalized persons; licenses. A license for the taking of fish may be issued by the commissioner of conservation to any person who is a ward of the commissioner of public welfare and who is institutionalized in an institution under the control of the commissioner of public welfare, upon application by the commissioner of public welfare to the commissioner of conservation. Any license issued under this subdivision shall be issued without cost.
