An act relating to appropriations heretofore made to the railroad and warehouse commission; rendering void and of no effect certain limitations on the use thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Railroad and warehouse commission; appropriation. The limitation on the use of the appropriation made to the railroad and warehouse commission for salaries by Extra Session Laws 1961, Chapter 88, Section 27, Subdivision 1(a), which prohibited the expenditure of any such appropriation for the salary of an assistant or special assistant attorney general is hereby rendered void and of no effect.

## CHAPTER 479-S. F. No. 322

An act relating to state colleges, authorizing the state college board to issue revenue bonds payable from "the college board of the state of Minnesota, revenue fund", and to expend the moneys so obtained and other moneys to acquire, construct, complete, remodel, and equip structures to be used for dormitory, residence hall, student union, and foor service purposes; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 136.41, by adding a new subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. State colleges; revenue bonds. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 136.41, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

[Subd. 3.] The state college board or any successor thereof is authorized to issue additional revenue bonds under sections 136.31 to 136.38, subject to the provisions of the resolutions authorizing its outstanding revenue bonds, and payable solely from the revenue appropriated thereto by section 136.11, subdivision 6, and sections 136.31 to 136.38, in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding 13 million dollars, over and above the amounts of bonds authorized elsewhere in this section, and to use the proceeds of their sale, together with other public or private money which may otherwise be-
