polls and set them in proper manner for use at the election. The custodians of voting machines shall be paid for their services commensurate with the work required and their compensation shall be fixed by the governing body of the municipality or county appointing them.

## CHAPTER 653-H. F. No. 1950

#### [Not Coded]

An act to authorize the village council of the village of Circle Pines to refund outstanding revenue bonds with term bonds; legalizing proceedings heretofore taken.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Circle Pines, village of; refunding bonds. The village council of the village of Circle Pines is authorized to refund outstanding revenue bonds of the village with term bonds pursuant to agreement with the holder or holders of said outstanding bonds and all proceedings heretofore taken in the construction of improvements financed by said bonds or in the making of contracts relating to cash service pledged for the payment of said bonds are hereby validated. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 475, shall apply to the issuance of said refunding bonds except that said bonds need not be sold in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 475.60 and need not mature serially in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 475.54.
- Sec. 2. The only governmental unit to which this act applies is the village of Circle Pines and this act shall become effective when approved by resolution adopted by a majority of the members of the village council of the village of Circle Pines and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

# CHAPTER 654—H. F. No. 1962

An act relating to the salary of the judge of probate court of Wilkin county.

- Section 1. Wilkin county probate court; judge's salary. The annual salary of the judge of probate court of Wilkin county is \$8,000, beginning July 1, 1963, notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 525.081, Subdivision 1.
- Sec. 2. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 525.081, Subdivision 2, shall apply to the salary provided in section 1.

### CHAPTER 655-S. F. No. 178

An act relating to the state treasury; providing for standing appropriations for certain payments to counties as provided by law; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 252.044 and 252.045.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 252.044, is amended to read:
- 352.044 Mentally deficient; liability of estate of deceased patient. Upon the death of a patient or former patient, the total cost of care from the effective date of Extra Session Laws 1961, Chapter 62, regardless of the amount the patient was ordered to pay, less the amount actually paid toward the cost of care by the patient or his relatives, shall be allowed as a claim against the estate of such patient or former patient by the court having jurisdiction to probate the estate. All proceeds collected by the state in such case shall be divided between the state and county in proportion to the cost of care each has borne.

There is appropriated from the general revenue fund, or from the fund or account in the state treasury to which the money was credited, to the counties as provided by this section, an amount sufficient to make the necessary payments as are provided herein.

- Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 252.045, is amended to read:
- 252.045 Patient's county; payment to state; reimbursement. The patient's county shall pay quarterly to the state of Minnesota \$10 for each month or portion thereof the patient spends at the state institution. Any portion of said amount actually received by the state of Minnesota from the patient and his relatives shall be reimbursed
