The board shall investigate the matter and report its findings and recommendations in writing to the commissioner. Final determination of the amount of aid, if any, to be paid to the county from the disaster account shall be made by the commissioner. If the commissioner determines to aid any such county he shall certify to the state auditor the amount of the aid, and the state auditor shall thereupon issue a warrant in that amount payable to the county treasurer of the county. Money so paid shall be expended on the county state-aid highway system in accordance with the rules and regulations of the commissioner.

CHAPTER 76—S. F. No. 440

*An act relating to the prohibition of smoking in certain areas; providing penalties for the violation thereof; and amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 621.42.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 621.42, is amended to read:

**621.42 Smoking, where prohibited.** *Subdivision 1.* Every person who shall light a pipe, *cigarette*, or cigar in or shall enter with a lighted pipe, *cigarette*, or cigar, any mill or other building on which is posted in a conspicuous place, over or near each principal entrance, a notice, in plain, legible characters, stating that no smoking is allowed in such building, and every person who shall deface, destroy or remove any such notice, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished for each such offense by a fine of \$10.

*Subd. 2.* *When the state fire marshal, his deputies or assistants, upon inspection, shall find conditions such as to make smoking a hazard in any areas of piers, wharves, warehouses, stores, industrial plants, institutions, schools, places of assembly, and in any open spaces where combustible or flammable materials are stored and handled, he shall post, in a conspicuous location in each building, structure, room or area in which smoking shall be prohibited, signs reading "No Smoking By Order Of The State Fire Marshal."*

*Smoking shall mean and include the carrying of lighted pipe, cigar, cigarette, or tobacco in any form.*

*Any person who shall willfully smoke in any building, structure, room or area so posted and any person who shall destroy, deface, or remove any installed "No Smoking" sign, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished for each such offense by a fine of \$10.*

CHAPTER 77—S. F. No. 564

*An act relating to poultry associations; providing recognition of the change of name of an association receiving aid in payment of premiums at poultry exhibitions.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Valley Poultry Fanciers; appropriation.** For the purposes of distributing any money hereafter appropriated for aid in payment of premiums at exhibitions of poultry by poultry associations, the "Valley Poultry Fanciers" is the successor of the "Marshall County Poultry Association", which association is named in Laws 1949, Chapter 718, Section 7, Subdivision 8, and which association's name has been changed to "Valley Poultry Fanciers."

**Sec. 2.** This act takes effect upon final enactment.

CHAPTER 78—H. F. No. 237

*An act relating to Anoka county; authorizing the county of Anoka to furnish food and other necessities required by law to prisoners lodged in the county jail.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Anoka county; jail; services to prisoners.** The county board of the county of Anoka is hereby authorized to do any and all acts that the sheriff is authorized and directed to do in the furnishing of food, washing, and other services to the prisoners who are lodged in the said county jail, and the county board may, by resolution, enter into contracts for the furnishing of food and pro-
