Such card or certificate shall be in such form as the registrar may provide to the motor vehicle dealer for such purpose, and shall be carried by such buyer or prospective buyer while driving the motor vehicle or ~~motor~~ truck, *truck tractor, or semitrailer*.

CHAPTER 151—H. F. No. 678

An act relating to grand lodges of fraternal organizations created by territorial or state laws; authorizing a change in the place of establishment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Fraternal organizations; place of establishment.**
Subdivision 1. The grand lodge of any fraternal organization created by a special act of the legislature of the territory or of the state of Minnesota which designated the place of establishment may change the place of establishment thereof by conforming with the provisions of this act.

Subd. 2. The place of establishment of such grand lodge may be changed from time to time when authorized by a majority of the board of trustees or other governing body thereof and a majority of the members of the grand lodge; and the change shall become effective when a certificate, duly executed by the presiding officer and the secretary of such grand lodge, setting forth the change of the place of establishment and reciting compliance with the provisions of this act, is filed for record in the office of the secretary of state.

CHAPTER 152—H. F. No. 764

An act relating to the city of Brainerd and the county of Crow Wing; authorizing the city to issue airport bonds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Brainerd, city of; city-county airport bonds. The governing body of the city of Brainerd, which is acting jointly with the county of Crow Wing in the ownership or operation of a public airport, may issue and sell bonds of the city to provide funds for the construction or purchase of hangars, repair shops and other buildings on the airport site designed for the repair, reconstruction, servicing and storage of aeroplanes, which bonds may be payable from part or all of the revenues of the airport and may pledge the full faith, credit and taxing powers of the city for their payment, provided that the amount of such bonds outstanding at any time shall not exceed \$50,000. The powers herein granted are in addition to powers granted by Chapter 590, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1949 or any amendments thereof.

Sec. 2. This act shall be effective upon its approval by a majority of all the members of the council of the city of Brainerd and a majority of all the county commissioners of the county of Crow Wing, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
