An act relating to statutory provisions; providing for the correction of errors resulting from the enactment of conflicting and inconsistent provisions of law; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 168.27, by adding a new subdivision; 357.28, as amended, by adding a new subdivision; and repealing Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 168.27, Subdivision 5, as amended; and 296.22, Subdivision 2, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 168.27, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
- Subd. 5. Correction bill; plates; distinguishing numbers.

 (a) The registrar shall issue to every motor vehicle dealer, upon a request from such motor vehicle dealer licensed as provided in subdivision 1, one or more pair of number plates displaying a general distinguishing number upon the payment of \$10 to the registrar. Motor vehicles, new or used, owned by such motor vehicle dealer and bearing such number plates, except vehicles leased to the user, held for hire, or customarily used by the dealer as a tow truck, service truck, or pickup truck, may be driven upon the streets and highways of this state by such motor vehicle dealer, or any employee of such motor vehicle dealer or by any member of the immediate family of such dealer or employee for either private or business purposes; or may be driven upon the streets and highways for

demonstration purposes by any prospective buyer thereof for a period of 48 hours or in the case of a truck, truck-tractor, or semitrailer, for a period of seven days.

- A new motor vehicle sold by such motor vehicle dealer and bearing the motor vehicle dealer's number plates may be driven upon the public streets and highways for a period of 72 hours by the buyer for either of the following purposes: (1) Removing the vehicle from this state for registration in another state, or (2) permitting the buyer to use the motor vehicle before he receives number plates pursuant to his own registration. Use of a new motor vehicle by the buyer under under the provisions of clause (2) of the preceding sentence before he receives number plates pursuant to his own registration constitutes a use of the public streets or highways for the purpose of the time requirements for registration of motor vehicles. Upon the delivery of such new motor vehicle to the buyer or upon the delivery of such vehicle or motor truck, truck-tractor, or semi-trailer, new or used, to the prospective buyer for demonstration purposes, the motor vehicle dealer shall deliver to the buyer or prospective buyer, as the case may be, a card or certificate giving the name and address of the motor vehicle dealer, the name and address of such buyer or prospective buyer, and the date and hour of such delivery. Such card or certificate shall be in such form as the registrar may provide to the motor vehicle dealer for such purpose, and shall be carried by such buyer or prospective buyer while driving the motor vehicle or truck, truck-tractor, or semi-trailer.
- Sec. 2. Except for the provisions of clause (b), section 1 is effective on January 1, 1966. Clause (b) is in effect upon final enactment of this act.
- Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 357.28, as amended by Laws 1965, Chapter 117, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
- Subd. 2. Application. Subdivision 1 shall not apply to any county containing a city of the first class.
