CHAPTER 124—H. F. No. 238

An act relating to wild animals; providing for the taking of deer by persons hunting in groups.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [100.272] Deer, party hunting. Notwith-standing any other provision of law to the contrary a hunter may hold only one license to take deer by firearms in any year, and the license is valid to take only one deer. However, where two or more persons who hold valid licenses to take deer by use of firearms are hunting as a party any member of the party may take or kill the number of deer that is equal to the number of valid licenses held by members of the party. In no case shall the total number of deer taken by members of the party exceed the total number of valid licenses held by members of the party.
