passenger automobile or truck is duly registered in his name in such foreign state, district, territory, or country.

- Subd. 2. Any person who knowingly sells or in any manner knowingly transfers title of a passenger automobile or truck to a person who is prohibited from owning a passenger auomobile or truck under the provisions of subdivision 1 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Any person who knowingly fails to mail in the application for registration or transfer to the registrar of motor vehicles or otherwise submits said forms to him within 14 days following date of sale shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- The registrar of motor vehicles shall refuse to reg-Subd. 3. ister a passenger automobile or truck unless the owner submits to the registrar, at the time the owner files his first application for registration or transfer of a passenger automobile or truck, a written and verified statement that he is 18 years of age or over or, if under the age of 18, that he is permitted by the provisions of subdivision 1 to own a passenger automobile or truck. The applieant's statement of an applicant under the age of 18 also shall set forth the number of the applicant's drivers license, or if the applicant has no drivers license he shall so state. The applicant shall make an oath or affirmation before an officer authorized by law to administer oaths and affirmations that the statements made are correct and true. The registrar may prescribe a form for the statement required by this subdivision, which form the registrar may make a part of the application for registration or transfer.
- Subd. 4. A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor. The commissioner of highways shall suspend, for not less than one year, the drivers license of a person who, while under the age of 18, misrepresents his age on the statement required by subdivision 3.

## CHAPTER 179-S. F. No. 643

An act relating to the firemen's relief association in the city of Duluth.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Duluth, city of; firemen's relief association. member of the firemen's relief association in the city of Duluth who has completed a period, or periods of service on the fire department equal to 20 years or more, shall, after he has arrived at the age of 50 years, or more, and has retired from the payroll of the fire department, be entitled to a basic pension of not less than 20 units and not more than 32 units per month for his natural life in conformity to the bylaws of such association. Any and all leaves of absence of more than 90 days, except such as are granted to a member because of his disability due to sickness or accident, shall be excluded in computing said period of service; and all periods of time during which a member received a disability pension shall be excluded in such computation. No deductions shall be made for a leave of absence granted to a member to enable him to accept an appointive position in said fire department. No member shall be entitled to draw both a disability and a service pension.

Such monthly basic payments may be increased by adding to said basic pension the sum of one additional unit for each of the first three years of such service in excess of 20 years and one and one half additional units for each year of such service in excess of 23 years. The bylaws of such association may provide for these increases, or any portion thereof; provided, that in no event shall the total pension exceed the sum of 40 units per month.

Said unit shall be  $\frac{1}{80}$ th of the maximum monthly salary including longevity of a first-grade firefighter on January 1 of the current calendar year in which the pensions provided for in this act are paid.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by the city council of the city of Duluth, and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
