which lies northerly of a line run parallel with and distant 165 feet southerly of the North line of said Lot 16, southeasterly of a line run parallel with and distant 100 feet southeasterly of the first following described line and northeasterly of the second following described line:

Line 1. Beginning at a point on the North and South quarter line of Section 2, Township 118 North, Range 21 West, distant 127.10 feet South of the center of said Section 2; thence run southwesterly at an angle of $52^{\circ}32'$ with said North and South quarter line for 2790.30 feet, and there terminating;

Line 2. Beginning at the point of termination of said Line 1, described above; thence run southeasterly at right angles with said Line 1 for 300 feet and there terminating;

containing 1.06 acres, more or less;
together with an easement, for roadway purposes only, in that part of the easterly 40 feet of the above described tract, which lies southerly of a line run parallel with and distant 165 feet southerly of the North line of said Lot 16; containing 0.32 acre, more or less; subject to the following restrictions: No access shall be permitted to Trunk Highway No. 100 from the above described real estate. Also, no construction or alteration shall be permitted within the above described 40 foot easement without specific written approval from the commissioner of highways or his designated representative. Further subject to the right of the state to enter upon the premises to maintain or reconstruct its storm sewer and drainage facilities.

Sec. 2. The consideration to be paid by the village of Brooklyn Center to the state of Minnesota for deposit into the trunk highway fund for the real estate to be conveyed hereunder shall be in the amount of \$3600.

CHAPTER 233—H. F. No. 917

An act relating to the admissibility of assets of insurance companies other than life.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **[60.201] Insurance companies; admitted assets of insurance companies other than life.** The admitted assets of an insurance company other than life shall include, in addition to all other admitted assets, an electronic computer or data processing machine or system heretofore or hereafter purchased for use in connection with the business of the company, provided that such machine or system shall have an original cost of not less than \$100,000 nor more than three percent of the admitted assets of the company and such cost shall be amortized in full over a period not to exceed ten full calendar years.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 234—H. F. No. 930

An act relating to Rice county; authorizing the establishment of a civil service system for the sheriff's office.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Rice county; sheriff; civil service.** Rice county may establish, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 387.32 to 387.45, a civil service personnel system for personnel in the sheriff's office.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect when approved by the county board of Rice county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
