

CHAPTER 400—S. F. No. 1147

An act authorizing the sale of certain state owned land in Anoka county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Conveyance of state lands; Anoka county.** When the commissioner of public welfare shall certify to the commissioner of administration that the land hereinafter described is no longer needed for state purposes, the commissioner of administration shall offer it for sale to the highest responsible bidder upon two weeks' published notice in a newspaper of general circulation in Anoka county. The land is situated in the county of Anoka and is described as follows:

Northeast Quarter (NE¼) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼),
Section 9, Township 31, Range 24, Anoka County, State of
Minnesota.

Sec. 2. Sale shall be made for cash to the highest responsible bidder, and the governor upon recommendation of the commissioner of administration, shall execute and deliver to the successful bidder a quitclaim deed conveying the land in such form as the attorney general shall prescribe.

Sec. 3. If in the opinion of the commissioner no satisfactory bids are received, he may reject all bids and reoffer such land for sale as hereinabove provided.
