The South 208 feet of the West 401 feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 110 North, Range 20 West of the 5th Principal Meridian in the City of Faribault, Rice County, Minnesota, subject to a driveway easement over the North 16 feet of the South 162 feet thereof and also subject to an easement for street purposes over the West 33 feet thereof and containing in all about 1.915 acres.

Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized under section 1 shall be made upon conveyance to the state by William A. Steigauf, and his wife, if any, of a driveway easement over the lands described in section 1, such easement and the description thereof to be as the commissioner determines necessary. The form of the deed of easement to the state shall be approved by the attorney general and the conveyance shall only be accepted upon approval by the attorney general of the title to the lands so conveyed.

An act relating to Wadena county; authorizing a tax levy for a new courthouse building.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Wadena county; courthouse. The county board of Wadena county may levy annually a tax of not to exceed eight mills on the dollar of all taxable property in the county for a building fund for a new courthouse building. The levy of such tax shall be made at the same time as the levy for general purposes of the county are made. The levy authorized herein is over and above and in excess of any per capita mill or other taxing limitation upon said county.
- Sec. 2. This act is effective upon its approval by all the members of the county board of Wadena county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
