

CHAPTER 569—H. F. No. 1403

An act relating to the municipal court of the city of Duluth; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 488A.66, Subdivision 1, Subdivision 2, as amended, and Subdivision 3, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 488A.66, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

488A.66 Municipal court of Duluth; salaries. Subdivision 1. ~~The salary of the judges of said municipal court shall be \$12,000 per annum. Each judge of the municipal court of the city of Duluth shall be paid an annual salary of \$14,500 in semimonthly installments out of the treasury of the city of Duluth.~~

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 488A.66, Subdivision 2, as amended by Laws 1963, Chapter 697, Section 1, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. ~~The salary of the clerk of said municipal court shall be \$8,400 per annum and the salary of the probation officer shall be \$7,800 per annum. In case additional deputy clerks shall be appointed with the consent and sanction of the city council of the city of Duluth, as provided in section 488A.40, subdivision 2, the said city council shall fix the compensation of the deputy or deputies so appointed. No judge of the municipal court of the city of Duluth, except the special municipal judge, shall practice as an attorney or counsellor at law, nor shall he be a partner of any practicing attorney in the business of his profession.~~

Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 1961, section 488A.66, Subdivision 3, as amended by Laws 1963, Chapter 697, Section 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 3. ~~The salary of the official court reporter appointed under section 488A.42, subdivision 1, shall be \$7800 per annum. The salary of each officer shall be payable from the city treasury of Duluth in semimonthly installments, and neither of said officers shall receive any fee or compensation except as herein provided. The clerk, probation officer, and official court reporter of the municipal court of the city of Duluth shall be paid in accordance with a pay plan or plans recommended by the judges of the municipal court of the city of Duluth and adopted by ordinance of the Duluth city council. In case additional clerks shall be appointed, with the consent and sanction of the city council of the city of Duluth, as provided in section 488A.40, subdivision 2, the said city council shall fix the compensation of the deputy or deputies so appointed. The salary~~

of each officer shall be payable from the city treasury of the city of Duluth in semimonthly installments and none of said officers shall receive any fee or compensation except as herein provided.

Sec. 2. *This act shall take effect as of January 1, 1965.*

CHAPTER 570—H. F. No. 1535

An act relating to the probate court of St. Louis county; fixing the salary of the judge, referee and clerk thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **St. Louis county probate court; salaries.** The annual salary of the judge of probate court of St. Louis county is \$17,000, notwithstanding the provisions of Laws 1961, Chapter 610, Section 1.

Sec. 2. **Probate court of St. Louis county; salary of referee and clerk.** The annual salary of the referee in probate court of St. Louis county is \$2,500 and the annual salary of the clerk of probate court of St. Louis county is \$10,000, notwithstanding the provisions of Laws 1955, Chapter 747, Section 2, as amended by Extra Session Laws 1959, Chapter 3, Section 2, and Laws 1957, Chapter 616, Section 1, respectively.
