An act relating to public employees retirement association; authorizing legal representatives of certain survivors to obtain refunds of certain contributions of former members.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [353.81] Public employees retirement; refunds to certain survivors. Notwithstanding any provision in Minnesota Statutes 1961, Chapter 353, and any act amendatory thereof to the contrary, the legal representative of the estate of a survivor who received benefits from the public employees retirement fund, and who died on May 9, 1963, may apply for and obtain a refund of the difference between the deceased members contributions to the fund and the amount of benefits paid to the survivor.

- Section 1. Laws 1945, Chapter 561, Section 1, as amended by Laws 1949, Chapter 64, Section 1, is amended to read:
- Section 1. Ramsey county; abstract clerk; fees. In counties having more than 300,000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants Ramsey county:
- (a) The records and indexes in the office of county abstract clerk are hereby designated and defined as public records, open to inspection, but only to the extent in this section provided.
- (b) Every record, index, abstract copy, plat, bookkeeping record, or paper of any type whatsoever, prepared in such office, shall be the property of the county for the use of the county abstract clerk and his successors in office, and shall at the expiration of the term of any such abstract clerk be turned over to his successor in office.
