

(4) Issuing an execution and filing the return thereof; issuing a writ of attachment, injunction, habeas corpus, mandamus, quo warrants, certiorari, or other writs not specifically mentioned, \$2.

(5) Issuing a transcript of judgment, or for filing and docketing a transcript of judgment from another court, \$3.

(6) Filing and entering a satisfaction of judgment, partial satisfaction or assignment of judgment, \$1.

(7) Certificate as to existence or non-existence of judgments docketed, 50 cents for each name certified to and 50 cents for each judgment certified to.

(8) Filing and indexing trade name; or recording notary commission; or recording basic science certificate; or recording certificate of physicians, dentists, osteopaths, chiropractors, veterinarians, or optometrists, \$1.

(9) Filing and entering notice of appeal of bond and making return on appeal to supreme court, \$5.

(10) All other services required by law for which no fee is provided, such fee as compares favorably with those herein provided, or such as may be fixed by rule or order of the court.

Sec. 2. Subdivision 1. All fees of said clerk, except in criminal proceedings, shall be paid in advance at or prior to the time of the performance of any service requiring payment of such fees, and said clerk shall not proceed in any matter requiring the payment of fees until the full amount of the same is paid.

Subd. 2. This act shall not affect any actions or proceedings that have been or are pending in said court on the effective date hereof.

Sec. 3. This act is effective on July 1, 1965.

CHAPTER 666—S. F. No. 132

An act relating to the salaries of the auditor and treasurer of Goodhue county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Goodhue county; auditor and treasurer; salaries.** Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, the annual salary of the county auditor and county treasurer of Goodhue county shall each be set by the board of county commissioners in an amount not less than \$7,500 nor more than \$9,500 per year.

Sec. 2. The aforesaid salary shall constitute the base salary and the auditor and treasurer shall be entitled to any cost of living increases hereafter granted under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 375.43, and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto.

Sec. 3. Nothing contained in section 1 shall be construed as limiting the right of the auditor and treasurer to collect and retain fees, per diem payments, or any other payment which they are now authorized to collect in addition to the stated amount of their monthly salary.

Sec. 4. This act takes effect when approved by the county board of Goodhue county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 667—S. F. No. 246

An act relating to the salary of the auditor of Watonwan county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Watonwan county; auditor; salary.** Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, the annual salary of the county auditor of Watonwan county shall be set by the board of county commissioners in an amount not less than \$6,500 nor more than \$7,500 per year.

Sec. 2. The aforesaid salary shall constitute the base salary and the auditor shall be entitled to any cost of living increases hereafter granted under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 375.43, and acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto.

Sec. 3. Nothing contained in section 1 shall be construed as limiting the right of the auditor to collect and retain fees, per diem payments, or any other payment which he is now authorized to collect in addition to the stated amount of his monthly salary.
