

CHAPTER 777—H. F. No. 1625

An act relating to educational television; reappropriating money appropriated by Extra Session Laws 1959, Chapter 48.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Educational television; reappropriation.** The unexpended balances remaining on June 30, 1965, of moneys appropriated by Extra Session Laws 1959, Chapter 48, are reappropriated and made available for the biennium beginning July 1, 1965, notwithstanding the provisions of Extra Session Laws 1959, Chapter 48, Section 3, to the contrary.

CHAPTER 778—H. F. No. 1712

An act relating to assignment of wages; payroll deductions; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 181.06.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 181.06, is amended to read:

181.06 Labor; assignment of wages; payroll deduction. Every assignment, sale, or transfer, however made or attempted, of wages or salary to be earned or to become due, in whole or in part, more than 60 days from and after the date of making such transfer, sale or assignment shall be absolutely void. A written contract may be entered into between an employer and an employee wherein the employee authorizes the employer to make payroll deductions for the purpose of paying union dues, premiums of any life insurance, hospitalization and surgical insurance, group accident and health insurance, group term life insurance, group annuities or contributions to credit unions or a community chest fund, *or Minnesota benefit association*, or participation in any employee stock purchase plan or savings plan for periods longer than 60 days.
