Sec. 2. The authority and powers herein conferred shall be in addition to the powers and authority conferred upon the council by the charter of the city.

Sec. 3. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Saint Paul and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 794—S. F. No. 2079

An act relating to the salary of the county treasurer of Chippewa county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Chippewa county; treasurer's salary.** Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the contrary, the annual salary of the county treasurer of Chippewa county shall be set by the county board of commissioners of Chippewa county in an amount not less than \$6,800 per annum but not to exceed \$7,500 per annum.

Sec. 2. The aforesaid salary shall constitute the base salary and said treasurer shall be entitled to any cost of living increase hereafter granted under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 375.43.

Sec. 3. Nothing contained in section 1 of this act shall be construed as limiting the right of said treasurer to collect and retain fees or any other payment which he is now authorized to collect in addition to the stated amount of his monthly salary.

Sec. 4. This act becomes effective upon approval by the county board of Chippewa county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
