

CHAPTER 871—H. F. No. 989

An act relating to motor vehicles of the game warden service; eliminating special markings for such vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [168.012] **Motor vehicles; game wardens.** [Subdivision 1a.] Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 168.012, or any other law to the contrary, motor vehicles of the game warden service need not be specially marked in any way.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon final enactment.

CHAPTER 872—H. F. No. 1354

An act relating to township mutual fire insurance companies; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 67.30.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 67.30, is amended to read:

67.30 Township mutual fire insurance; types of insurance authorized. A township mutual fire insurance company shall insure only against loss or damage by fire, lightning, explosion, flood, earthquake, theft, vandalism, collapse of bridges, upset, overturn, collision, riot, riot attending a strike, civil commotion, aircraft, vehicles, and smoke to the property authorized to be insured in Minnesota Statutes, sections 67.09 and 67.27, and livestock against loss or damage by electrocution by electrical currents artificially generated, attack by dogs or wild animals, drowning, accidental shooting, loading or unloading, collapse of buildings or straw or hay stacks, or collision or overturn of conveyances, *breakage of glass, weight of ice, snow or sleet, freezing, leakage of water or other substance, electrical power interruption or electrical breakdown from any cause and consequential losses as a result of damage from any of the perils listed except public liability*, and it shall not issue any policy for a term of more than five years.
