authority has power by law to execute in a like manner. In contracting with so-called managing agent, but in remaining the terminal operator, the seaway port authority may contract to retain power over the setting of all rates for any services to be performed in any terminal facility owned, leased, or operated by said seaway port authority.

CHAPTER 470-H. F. No. 1245

An act relating to registered land surveys; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 508.47, Subdivision 4.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 508.47, Subdivision 4, is amended to read:

Subd. 4. Registered lands; survey; taxes; requisites; filing; The registered land survey shall correctly show the legal description of the parcel of unplatted land represented by said registered land survey and the outside measurements of the parcel of unplatted land and of all tracts delineated therein, the direction of all lines of said tracts to be shown by angles or bearings or other relationship to the outside lines of said registered land survey, and the surveyor shall place stakes in the ground at appropriate corners, and all tracts shall be lettered consecutively beginning with the letter "A". None of said tracts or parts thereof may be dedicated to the public by said registered land survey. The registered land survey shall be on paper, mounted on cloth, shall be a black on white drawing, the scale to be not smaller than one inch equals 200 feet, and shall be certified to be a correct representation of said parcel of unplatted land by a registered surveyor. The mounted drawing shall be exactly 17 inches by 14 inches and not less than 2 1/2 inches of the 14 inches shall be blank for binding purposes, and such survey shall be filed in triplicate with the registrar of titles upon the payment of a fee of \$10. Before filing, however, any such survey shall be approved in the manner required for the approval of subdivision plats, which approval shall be endorsed thereon or attached thereto. Before any such survey is filed, there shall be endorsed on all copies thereof required to be furnished, the certification of the county treasurer to the effect that the current real estate taxes upon the land described in said survey have been paid in full and the certification by

the county auditor that the real estate taxes for all prior years against the land described in said survey have been paid in full.

The registrar shall furnish to any person a copy of said registered land survey, duly certified by him, for a fee of \$5, which shall be admissible in evidence.

CHAPTER 471—H. F. No. 1297

An act relating to the selection of jurors for the municipal court of the city of Saint Paul; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 488A.24, Subdivision 1, and adding a new subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 488A.24, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 488A.24 St. Paul municipal court; petit jurors. Subdivision 1. Selection; list. Before the first day of June in each year, the judges shall select from the electors of the eity of Saint Paul county of Ramsey a list of persons properly qualified to serve as petit jurors and certify the list to the clerk of this court. If there be a deficiency of persons on the list, the judges may select from the electors of the eity of Saint Paul county of Ramsey additional persons to cover the deficiency and certify and deliver to the clerk a supplementary list which shall thereafter stand as part of the original list. The validity of the selection is not affected by the fact that any person is disqualified from serving as a juror.
- Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 488A.24, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:
- Subd. 6. Court rule on selection. (a) If a court rule so providing is adopted by a majority of the judges of said district court and also by a majority of the judges of the municipal court, all petit jurors to serve in the municipal court of the city of Saint Paul may be selected from the petit jurors summoned for jury service by the district court of Ramsey county.
- (b) The rule may provide the manner in which jurors for the municipal court shall be selected from the jurors summoned by
