561.07 Animals; impounding. Any person may, and every sheriff, constable and police officer shall, distrain and impound all such animals and fowls any cattle, horses, mules, sheep, swine, or any domestic fowls so running at large or trespassing upon the lands of another or upon any public property in this state, and when so impounded such proceedings shall be had relative to the animals and fowls so impounded as are or shall be provided by the general laws of this state relating to the impounding of animals.

## CHAPTER 517-H. F. No. 924

An act relating to assignment, sale or transfer of wages or salary, and exempting wages or salary to be earned in excess of the first \$1,500 per month from the prohibition against assignment, sale or transfer for more than 60 days; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 181.06.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 181.06, is amended to read:

181.06 Assignment of wages; validity. Every assignment, sale, or transfer, however made or attempted, of wages or salary to be earned or to become due, in whole or in part, more than 60 days from and after the date of making such transfer, sale or assignment shall be absolutely void; provided however, that the foregoing restriction against transfer, sale or assignment shall not apply to any assignment, sale or transfer of that portion of wages or salary to be earned or to become due in excess of the first \$1,500 per month where such assignment is for less than five years. A written contract may be entered into between an employer and an employee wherein the employee authorizes the employer to make payroll deductions for the purpose of paying union dues, premiums of any life insurance, hospitalization and surgical insurance, group accident and health insurance, group term life insurance, group annuities or contributions to credit unions or a community chest fund, or Minnesota benefit association, or participation in any employee stock purchase plan or savings plan for periods longer than 60 days.
