Any person removing a wrecked or damaged vehicle from a highway shall remove any glass or other injurious substance dropped upon the highway from such vehicle.

No person shall drop or hurl any destructive or injurious material or object at or upon any motor vehicle upon any highway or the occupants thereof.

CHAPTER 105-H. F. No. 536

An act authorizing the conveyance of certain lands owned by the state to the city of Northfield.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Conveyance of state lands; city of Northfield. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the governor, upon recommendation of the commissioner of administration based upon a statement in writing by the commissioner of highways that the lands are no longer needed for trunk highway purposes, may convey by quitclaim deed, in such form as the attorney general approves, to the city of Northfield, the following described lands located in the county of Rice, Minnesota, to-wit:

All of the following described tract:

Block 35, Original Town, now City of Northfield, according to the plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Rice County;

together with all that part of the two following described tracts;

- 1. Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, Block 36, Original Town, now City of Northfield, according to said plat;
- 2. That part of Block 45, Block 62 and Block 63 of the Original Town, now City of Northfield, according to said plat, lying northwesterly of the northwesterly shore line of the Cannon River which lies southeasterly of a line run parallel with and distant 75 Feet southeasterly of the following described line:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of Second Street with the center line of Water Street; thence run southwesterly along the center line of Water Street for 65.5

Feet; thence deflect to the right at an angle of 31°03′15″ for 1219.7 Feet; thence deflect to the right on a 0° 26′ curve (delta angle 9°08′15″) for 2108.8 Feet and there terminating.

- Sec. 2. The city of Northfield shall use said Block 35, and that part of Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Block 36, described in section 1 for public purposes and the balance of the lands described in section 1 for park purposes. In the event the city fails to use or abandons the use of the lands for such purposes the same shall revert to the state of Minnesota.
- Sec. 3. The consideration to be paid by the city of Northfield to the state of Minnesota for deposit in the trunk highway fund for the conveyance of the lands herein described shall be in the amount of \$2,360.

CHAPTER 106-H. F. No. 548

An act relating to Blue Earth county; authorizing the appointment of a county assessor and deputies; abolishing the offices of town, village, and city assessor in said county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Blue Earth county; assessors. The board of county commissioners of the county of Blue Earth shall appoint a county assessor on the first Monday in January, or as soon thereafter as practicable, on the odd-numbered year, who shall hold office for a term of four years, and until his successor is appointed and qualified. The board of county commissioners shall fill all vacancies in the office of county assessor for an unexpired term or otherwise occasioned by a death, resignation, removal, or other cause and may remove an assessor from office at any time.

The board of county commissioners may appoint and employ one chief deputy and the necessary additional deputies, clerks, field men, appraisers, or employees for the proper performance of the duties of the office of county assessor; and shall by resolution fix the compensation to be paid to the assessor, his deputies, clerks, field men, appraisers, and other employees.

Sec. 2. The board of county commissioners shall spend in the manner and amount it deems necessary, money needed to defray the
