

## CHAPTER 161—S. F. No. 178

*An act relating to the city of Chisholm; providing for a tax levy for library purposes.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Chisholm, city of; library tax levy.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law or city charter, the governing body of the city of Chisholm may levy annually on all real and personal property within the city:

(a) A tax not to exceed \$30,000 for the establishment, maintenance and government of the libraries of the city and for the payment of all their expenses proper and incident to the establishment, maintenance and government of the libraries of which tax three mills may be in excess of any charter or statutory limitations;

(b) A tax of one mill on each dollar of the assessed valuation of said city which shall be placed into the library permanent improvement fund or expended for the maintenance and current expenses of said libraries as may be determined by the city council of the city of Chisholm.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon its approval by the governing body of the city of Chisholm, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

## CHAPTER 162—S. F. No. 283

*An act relating to verification by applicant for old age assistance; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 256.19, Subdivisions 2 and 3.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 256.19, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **Old age assistance; application.** An applicant for old age assistance, *or a person acting in his behalf*, shall file his application in writing with the county agency of the county in which he is residing, in such manner and form as shall be prescribed by the state agency.
