CHAPTER 164-S. F. No. 315

An act relating to verification by applicant for aid to blind; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 256.54, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 256.54, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

256.54 Aid to blind; applications. Subdivision 1. Application An applicant or a person acting in his ner of making. behalf, shall apply for assistance under sections 256.49 to 256.71 shall be made to the county agency of the county in which the applicant is residing. The application shall be in writing, or reduced to writing in the manner and upon the form prescribed by the state agency, and verified by the oath of the applicant or a person acting in his behalf, or in lieu thereof, the application shall contain the following declaration which shall be signed by the applicant or a person acting in his behalf: "I declare that this application has been examined by me and to the best of my knowledge and belief is a true and correct statement of every material point". Such application shall contain a statement of the amount of property, both personal and real, in which the applicant has an interest and of all income which he may have at the time of the filing of the application and such other information as may be prescribed by the state agency.

CHAPTER 165-S. F. No. 439

An act prohibiting certain commercial activities on Sunday and certain holidays; providing for penalties for violation thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. [325.91] Sunday closing; definitions. Subdivision 1. For the purpose of this act, the terms defined in this section shall have the meanings given them.
- Subd. 2. "Person" means any individual, partnership, corporation, association, or other group, however organized, and includes agents and employees.
 - Subd. 3. "Sunday" means the first day of the calendar week.
