

## CHAPTER 186—H. F. No. 1385

*An act relating to tax levies for payment of principal of and interest on bonds of United Hospital District in Faribault county.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Faribault county; hospital; tax levies.** In submitting a proposal to issue bonds of United Hospital District, a duly organized hospital district in Faribault county, Minnesota, to the voters of said district, as provided by Minnesota Statutes, Section 447.35, the hospital board of said district is authorized to add to the proposal on the ballot the following proviso: Provided that said bonds shall be paid by ad valorem taxes apportioned so that the millage rate on properties within any incorporated city or village in the district shall be twice the millage rate on properties in towns in the district.

**Sec. 2.** If the proposal to issue bonds including said proviso is approved by a majority of the voters of the district, the county auditor shall apportion taxes levied for payment of principal and interest on said bonds in accordance with said proviso.

**Sec. 3.** This act shall become effective upon its approval by a resolution adopted by a majority of all members of the governing body of the United Hospital District, and of each of the following cities, villages and towns situated therein: the city of Blue Earth; the villages of Frost, Winnebago, and Elmore; and the towns of Emerald, Blue Earth, Elmore, Pilot Grove, Jo Daviss, Verona, Winnebago, and Prescott; and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
