Subd. 11a. Municipal court of Hennepin county; governmental units; fee exclusions. Any provision of law relating to the municipal court of Hennepin county to the contrary notwithstanding, no fees shall be charged by the clerk of said municipal court to any governmental unit of the state of Minnesota or any agency thereof, located in whole or in part within the county of Hennepin when said governmental unit or any agency thereof transacts any business in, or they are a party to any action or proceeding in, the Hennepin county municipal court.

CHAPTER 251-H. F. No. 1308

An act relating to the salaries of the members of the board of education of Independent School District No. 381, Lake county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Independent School District No. 381; board members' salaries. Subdivision 1. Notwithstanding any provision of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 123.33, Subdivision 12, and 128.05, to the contrary the members of the board of Independent School Dis-

- trict No. 381, Lake County, may receive \$20 while attending any regular or special meeting of the board, but not more than \$400 in any one year, and receive seven and one-half cents per mile in going to and from his place of residence to the place of meeting by the usual route of travel.
- Subd. 2. The chairman, clerk, and treasurer of the said school district may receive such additional compensation as may be fixed by the board. The chairman shall not receive more than \$400, the clerk shall not receive more than \$720, and the treasurer not more than \$600 in any one year.
- Subd. 3. Any other provisions of said sections 123.33, subdivision 12, and 128.05, not in conflict with this act, applicable to said school district and its board, are not affected by this act.
- Sec. 2. This act takes effect upon approval by the governing body of Independent School District No. 381, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 252-H. F. No. 1345

An act to provide for the classification of employees of special school district No. 3, Duluth, Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Special school district No. 3; employees to be classified. The employees of special school district No. 3, Duluth, Minnesota, shall be eligible to be classified and shall be classified as employees under the provisions of the charter of the city of Duluth pursuant to which a civil service board has been or may be established.
- Sec. 2. Exceptions. The term "employees", as used in this act, shall not include members of the board of education, superintendent of schools, assistant superintendent of schools, clerk of the board, teachers, including principals and supervisors, chief engineer, director of physical plant, recreational director, administrative assistant in charge of communications, all other administrative assistants, budget director, physicians, dentists, and temporary employees.
