An act relating to the commissioner of highways; authorizing the use of certain state owned property temporarily for the launching of boats being produced for the federal government.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Knife Lake; temporary boat launch. The commissioner of highways may permit the use of certain state owned property under his jurisdiction located on the east shore of Knife Lake in Kanabec county for the launching and removal of certain boats being constructed for the federal government upon such terms and conditions as he may prescribe and for a period of time not extending beyond July 1, 1969.

An act relating to the construction of interstate highway rest area buildings; appropriating moneys for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Interstate highways; rest areas; appropriation. In order to carry out the recommendations of the legislative building commission as contained in its biennial report to the legislature, made pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Sections 3.421 to 3.471, there is appropriated to the commissioner of highways from any moneys in the state treasury credited to the trunk highway fund the sum of \$480,000 for the interstate highway facilities described therein:

- 1 Northwest of Ashby on Interstate 94
- 4 Eastbound lane of Interstate 94, west of Alexandria
- West of Stewartville on Interstate 90 5
- Northbound lane of Interstate 35, north of Sandstone
