CHAPTER 267—S. F. No. 1391

*An act relating to the city of Stillwater; authorizing the issuance of an additional "on-sale" license for the sale of intoxicating liquor.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Stillwater, city of; liquor licenses.** The city of Stillwater may issue, in addition to the five "on-sale" liquor licenses authorized by law, one "on-sale" license to a hotel which operates a dining room serving meals regularly and which contains not less than 40 guest rooms.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect upon its approval by the governing body of the city of Stillwater, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 268—H. F. No. 290

*An act relating to highway traffic regulations; eliminating the requirement that emergency vehicles sound sirens when escorting a vehicle or load which is oversize or overweight; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 169.20, Subdivision 5.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 169.20, Subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. **Traffic regulations; emergency vehicle; sirens.** Upon the immediate approach of an authorized emergency vehicle equipped with at least one lighted lamp exhibiting red light visible under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of 500 feet to the front of such vehicle and, *except where otherwise not required by law*, when the driver is giving audible signal by siren, the driver
