CHAPTER 30—H. F. No. 821

An act relating to the operation of state government; appropriating certain moneys therefor for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Operation of state government; appropriations.**
 Subdivision 1. The sums of money hereinafter set forth or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of the general revenue fund in the state treasury, or any other fund herein designated, to the departments and agencies and for the purposes hereinafter enumerated to be available for expenditure during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967.

Subd. 10. Department of Taxation

 CHAPTER 31—S. F. No. 106

An act relating to towns; authorizing town boards to designate precincts and polling places for the casting of ballots in town meetings; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Sections 365.51 and 365.52.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 365.51, is amended to read:

365.51 Towns; elections; precincts; polling places. There shall be an annual town meeting held in each town on the second Tuesday of March at the place of holding the last town meeting, or at such other place in the town, or in the city or village within or adjoining the same, designated by the annual town meeting. The clerk shall give ten days' published notice in a qualified newspaper having general circulation within the town or by posted notice, or both, as the voters at the annual town meeting may direct, specifying the time and place, but if the town meeting shall fail to direct the manner of
