

ty, Minnesota) is hereby authorized to issue and sell its bonds in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 over and above indebtedness heretofore incurred by it and any loans made to it under said section 124.43, for the purpose of acquisition and betterment of schoolhouses. Approval of the voters shall be required to authorize such bonds in the manner provided by law. Such bonds may be sold and issued in such amounts and at such times as may be determined by the school board; provided, that if prior to issuing any of such bonds the district obtains any capital loan or loans under said section 124.43, the amount of bonds authorized hereby shall be deemed to be reduced by the amount of such loan or loans.

Sec. 2. The board also may issue and sell its bonds to pay the balance due upon any outstanding capital loan, or to refund any portion thereof, without the question of authorizing the incurring of such debt being submitted to the voters, provided the authorizing resolution is adopted by the favorable vote of all of the members of the school board.

Sec. 3. The district may levy the taxes required by law for the payment of such bonds or loans and interest thereon without limitation as to rate or amount, and the levy of such taxes shall not cause the amount of other taxes, levied or to be levied by the district, which are subject to any such limitation, to be reduced in any amount whatsoever.

Sec. 4. Nothing herein repeals or otherwise affects the provisions of Laws 1965, Chapter 85.

Sec. 5. This act shall become effective upon its approval by a majority of the members of the school board of said district, and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

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#### CHAPTER 352—H. F. No. 1620

*An act authorizing the state and the city of Morris to exchange certain lands in Stevens county.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **State land exchange; city of Morris; exchange of**

**armory property.** Subdivision 1. The adjutant general, with the approval of the governor, may convey to the city of Morris the state's interest in and to the building known as the old armory in the city of Morris, in Stevens county, Minnesota, including the site thereof, described as follows: All of Lots 4, 5, 6, and the rear or southeasterly 60 feet of Lots 7, 8, 9, Block 27, City of Morris; for such public use as the city may make thereof. The conveyance shall be made only if the city of Morris, upon request of the adjutant general, conveys by quitclaim deed, to the Minnesota state armory building commission an adequate and suitable new armory site which is agreeable to the adjutant general.

Subd. 2. Minnesota Statutes, Section 193.36, Subdivision 3, has no application to the disposition of the old armory and site in the city of Morris.

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#### CHAPTER 353—H. F. No. 1626

*An act authorizing the conveyance of certain state lands in Dakota county.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Conveyance of state lands; Dakota county.** The governor, upon recommendation of the commissioner of public welfare, shall transfer and convey by quitclaim deed, in such form as the attorney general approves, in the name of the state of Minnesota, to Willis Olson, Hastings, Minnesota, for the consideration of not less than \$3,000, the following described lands in Dakota county:

Commencing at a point in the southwest quarter of section thirty-four (34), township one hundred fifteen (115), range seventeen (17) west, which is the northeast corner of the Hastings City Baseball Park, and which is a distance of seven hundred ninety and sixty-six hundredths (790.66) feet from the intersection of the center line of State Highway 316 (formerly known as State Aid Road No. 10) and the projection of the southeasterly line of lot twenty-three (23), block one (1) of Vermillion Addition to the City of Hastings, said distance being measured at right angles to the center line of said State Highway 316; proceeding thence southwesterly along the northwest

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
