151.15 Compounding drugs unlawful under certain conditions. It shall be unlawful for any person to compound, dispense, vend, or sell at retail, drugs, medicines, chemicals, or poisons in any place other than a pharmacy, except as provided in this chapter.

No proprietor of a pharmacy shall permit the compounding or dispensing of prescriptions except by a pharmacist, or by an assistant pharmacist, or by a pharmacist intern under the personal supervision of a pharmacist; or the vending or selling at retail of drugs, medicines, chemicals, or poisons in his pharmacy except under the personal supervision of a pharmacist or of an assistant pharmacist in the temporary absence of the pharmacist.

Sec. 4. Effective date. This act takes effect upon final enactment.

An act relating to certain lands lying within the village of Maplewood, in Ramsey county, and authorizing the governing body of said village to convey said lands.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Maplewood, village of; sale of land. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 282.01, Subdivision 1, the village of Maplewood is hereby authorized to sell at public sale, the property located within such village described as follows:

North fifty-one and fifty-six hundredths (N. 51.56) feet of South seven hundred eighty-three and seventy-five hundredths (S. 783.75) feet of West two hundred sixty-four (W. 264) feet of Southeast Quarter (SE ½) of Southeast Quarter (SE ½) of Section sixteen (16), Town twenty-nine (29), Range twenty-two (22), and also the North fifty-one and fifty-six hundredths (N. 51.56) feet of South seven hundred thirty-two and nineteen hundredths (S. 732.19) feet of West two hundred sixty-four (W. 264) feet of Southeast Quarter (SE ½) of Southeast Quarter (SE ½) of Section sixteen (16), Town twenty-nine (29), Range twenty-two (22), all according to the United

The city of Waseca may issue, in addition to the five "on-sale" liquor licenses authorized by law, one "on-sale" license to a hotel, motel, or other establishment which operates a dining room serving meals regularly, and which provides accommodations for transients and contains not less than 20 sleeping rooms.
