

CHAPTER 618—H. F. No. 1282

An act authorizing the village of Clara City to lease its nursing home facility as a hospital or nursing home or both.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Clara City, village of; nursing home; lease.** Any nursing home facility owned by the village of Clara City, in Chippewa county, including buildings and equipment, may be leased to a non-profit corporation upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreeable to the village and such corporation. Any lease may provide for the operation of such facility as a nursing home or hospital or both.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by the members of the governing body of the village of Clara City and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 619—H. F. No. 1465

An act relating to development corporations; providing for perpetual existence; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 301.71, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 301.71, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **Development corporations; perpetual existence.** They subscribe and acknowledge a certificate specifying:

(1) The name, the general nature of its business, and the principal place of transacting its business. The name shall distinguish the corporation from all other corporations authorized to do business in the state, and shall contain the words "Development Corporation".

(2) The period of its duration, which ~~shall be not more than 20 years~~ *may be limited or perpetual.*

(3) The name and residence of each incorporator.
