

Subd. 3. Upon payment in full of the purchase price and all taxes, penalties, and interest the county auditor shall so certify to the commissioner of taxation and if approved by the commissioner, the commissioner shall convey in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 282.01, the land described in subdivision 1, to Miles Homes, Inc.

CHAPTER 626—H. F. No. 2542

An act relating to education; residence and attendance of pupils in school districts; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Chapter 120, by adding a section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Chapter 120, is amended by adding a section to read:

[120.065] Education; school districts; farm in more than one district, attendance option. *When a pupil resides on a farm and the land comprising the farm is included in more than one district the pupil may attend the school of either district providing that if the pupil is to attend the school in the district of which he is not a resident he must first have the approval of the commissioner. A farm for the purposes of this section encompasses all tracts of land owned and operated as one farm, each of which is not less than 40 acres in area, providing no such tract is more than two miles distant from the tract of land on which the pupil resides. In the payment of state aid, the district in which the pupil attends shall be considered the district of his residence.*
