

Subd. 5. Custom spraying or dusting means spraying ~~and or~~ dusting operations *or both* as defined in subdivision 3 by a person ~~regularly~~ conducting a business of providing such operations for compensation.

Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 18.032, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

**18.032 License; records, fees.** Subdivision 1. A person, or his authorized agent, before carrying on spraying ~~and or~~ dusting operations *or both* for hire within this state, shall obtain a license from the commissioner. Application for this license shall be made upon forms and in such manner, which may include an examination, as the commissioner may prescribe, to enable him to determine if the applicant is qualified and his equipment suitable to perform the contemplated functions. Aerial applicators shall be licensed for commercial spraying ~~and or~~ dusting operations *or both* in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 360.013, Subdivision 11, such persons shall also secure an endorsement to their commercial spraying and dusting license from the commissioner of agriculture. *Before issuing such an endorsement the commissioner of agriculture shall determine by examination whether the applicant is knowledgeable in the application of pesticides or plant growth regulators. The inspection shall be administered by the department of aeronautics.*

Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 18.032, Subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. The license is effective until January 1 next following the date of its issuance, but may be renewed annually ~~and for subsequent years~~, in the manner and subject to the conditions governing its issuance originally. *However, a penalty of 50 percent of the license fee shall be imposed if a renewal application is not applied for on or before April 1 of each year.* A license shall not be transferrable from one person to another.

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## CHAPTER 691—S. F. No. 615

*An act relating to the sale of intoxicating liquors on Sundays; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 340.14 as amended, by adding a new subdivision thereto.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 340.14 as amended by Laws 1967, Chapter 19, Section 10, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

*Subd. 4. Sunday liquor sales. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 1, in any municipality establishments to which on sale licenses have been issued or hereafter may be issued for the sale of intoxicating liquors which are hotels or restaurants as defined in Laws 1967, Chapter 19, Section 1, and which have facilities for serving not less than 30 guests at one time, may serve intoxicating liquors between the hours of 12 o'clock noon and 12 o'clock midnight on Sundays in conjunction with the serving of food, but no liquor shall be served on Sundays other than to persons who are seated at tables.*

*(b) It is unlawful for any such establishment, directly or indirectly, to sell or serve such intoxicating liquors as provided in paragraph (a) above, without having first obtained a special license from the municipality therefor. Such special license may be issued by the governing body of the municipality for a period of one year and for such a fee as it shall determine, but not exceeding \$200. The special license may be revoked by the governing body, for cause. The provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.112 as amended by Laws 1967, Chapter 19, Section 6 shall apply to such license. Application for the special license shall be made to the governing body of the municipality in the same manner as application for other licenses to sell intoxicating liquor are made.*

*(c) This subdivision shall not apply to any municipality until authorized by the voters of the municipality voting on the question at a special election called for such purpose or at the general election in the municipality, the election to be conducted in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Minnesota election law.*
