An act relating to Norman county; authorizing the county board to issue general obligation bonds for improving roads and constructing bridges within the county without an election.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Norman county; roads and bridges; bonds. The board of county commissioners of Norman county may by resolution or resolutions authorize the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds (a) in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$100,000, the proceeds of which, together with any available funds of the county and anticipated funds from the United States of America, shall be used to pay the cost of improving County Road No. 142. All such general obligation bonds shall be issued and sold in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 475, except that an election shall not be required to authorize such bonds.
- Sec. 2. This act shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the board of county commissioners of Norman county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 753—H. F. No. 2349

An act relating to the county of Hennepin; authorizing the county board of such county to license and regulate the operation of ambulances in such county and the drivers and attendants of such ambulances.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Hennepin county; ambulances. The county board of Hennepin county may regulate the use of both public and private ambulances in such county. Such regulations may provide for the licensing of such vehicles providing for standards of operation including but not limited to requirements for equipment, sanitation, safety devices and such other requirements as the board may deem necessary.
- Sec. 2. The county board shall also have authority to license and regulate the drivers and attendants operating such ambulances and to enact reasonable rules and regulations providing for personal health and such other standards as the board may deem necessary.
- Sec. 3. The county board may impose reasonable yearly license fees not to exceed \$25 for each such vehicle, and not to exceed \$5 for each such operator or attendant. The fees for such licenses shall be paid into the general revenue fund of the county.
- Sec. 4. The county board is hereby authorized to make the necessary appropriations to carry out the provisions of this act.
- Sec. 5. This act shall become effective upon its approval by a majority of the governing body of the county of Hennepin and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 645.021.
