

American Legion Post #251, for such consideration as agreed upon, the state's interest to any or all of the following described lands in Hennepin county:

A parcel of land in the southwest quarter (SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section 5, township 29 north, range 24 west, being southwesterly of the southwesterly line of the Jefferson Highway and east of the east line of North France Avenue, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the east line of North France Avenue with the southwesterly line of Jefferson Highway, said point being distant 33 feet, east of the west line of said Section 5, and distant 476.91 feet north of the south line of said Section 5; thence south along the east line of said North France Avenue a distance of 150 feet; thence east at a right angle to the last described line a distance of 52.53 feet; thence northeasterly at an angle to the left from last described line of 38 degrees and 36 minutes a distance of 52.53 feet to a point in the southwesterly line of said Jefferson Highway (also known as West Broadway) said last mentioned point being 150 feet southeasterly from the point of beginning, being measured along the southwesterly line of said Jefferson Highway, thence northwesterly along the southwesterly line of said Jefferson Highway a distance of 150 feet to the place of beginning; containing 0.17 acres, more or less.

Sec. 2. The consideration received by the state for conveying the state's interest to the property described in section 1 shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the trunk highway fund.

#### CHAPTER 755—H. F. No. 2365

*An act relating to wild animals; fees for certain licenses; authorizing purchase of exporting minnow dealer license and vehicle license by administrator or executor of licensee's estate or his widow; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 98.46, Subdivision 5.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 98.46, Subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. **Wild animals; license fees.** Fees for the following licenses, to be issued to residents only, shall be:

- (1) To spear fish from a dark house, \$1;
- (2) For any fish house or dark house used during the winter fishing season, \$2 for each fish house or dark house not rented or offered for hire, and \$3 for each fish house or dark house rented or offered for hire;
- (3) To net whitefish, tullibees or herring from inland lakes or international waters, for domestic use only, for each net, \$1;
- (4) To conduct a taxidermist business, \$2;
- (5) To maintain fur and game farms, including deer, \$5;
- (6) To take mussels or clams, \$5;
- (7) To prepare dressed game fish shipments for nonresidents as provided by Minnesota Statutes, Section 97.45, Subdivision 6, as amended, \$10;
- (8) Itinerant minnow dealer, \$15 plus \$10 for each vehicle;
- (9) Itinerant minnow dealer's helper, \$2.50 for each helper. Itinerant minnow dealer's helpers' licenses shall be issued to the itinerant minnow dealer and are transferable by the dealer at will to his own helpers;
- (10) Exporting minnow dealer, \$200, plus \$10 for one vehicle only. No licenses to transport fathead minnows beyond the boundaries of the state will be issued for 1961 calendar year after the effective date of Laws 1961, Chapter 477, and the number issued prior to the effective date of Laws 1961, Chapter 477 will not be exceeded in subsequent years. The renewal of such existing licenses will be reserved through April 1 of the following year; licenses not so renewed will not be made available until the total number has been reduced to below 35 licenses.

Each vehicle license shall cover a specific truck, tractor-trailer, or semitrailer, the serial number, license number, make, and model shall be specified on the license which must be conspicuously posted in the vehicle licensed. No vehicle shall be licensed if the maximum tank capacity exceeds 300 cubic feet, inside measurement, and unless it complies with reasonable regulations adopted pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 101.42, Subdivision 5.

*The exporting minnow dealer's license and vehicle license are void upon the sale of the business or death of the licensee. Provided, however, a succeeding owner of the business upon meeting the required qualifications will be issued the required licenses upon application and payment therefor. In the event of the death of the licensee*

*the administrator or executor of the estate may purchase such licenses and operate the business until the sale thereof. If there is no estate then the widow or a member of the immediate family, if qualified, will be issued the required licenses upon application and payment therefor.*

CHAPTER 756—H. F. No. 2411

*An act relating to licensing requirements for food manufacturers, processors, and distributors; prescribing the powers and duties of the commissioner of agriculture in relation thereto; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 17.037, by adding a new subdivision.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 17.037, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

**Subd. 3. Food manufacturers, processors, and distributors; licensing, preemption by state.** *When a food manufacturer, processor, or distributor is licensed by the commissioner of agriculture, the food manufacturer, processor or distributor is exempt from the licensing requirements of any municipal corporation or subdivision of state government, except for licensing requirements which may be imposed by the municipal corporation or subdivision of state government in which the manufacturer, processor, or distributor locates a plant. All delivery equipment used by such a food manufacturer, processor or distributor is included within the meaning of this section, whether owned or operated, independently contracted, or contracted with a common carrier approved by the commissioner of agriculture. This delivery equipment is exempt from licensing by any municipal corporation or subdivision of state government except for those requirements which may be imposed by the municipal corporation or subdivision of state government in which the equipment is principally located. Delivery equipment approved by the commissioner of agriculture shall carry, at all times, a certificate of his approval for the purposes for which the equipment is utilized. Nothing in this*
