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CHAPTER 787—H. F. No. 2647

[Coded]

*An act relating to state parks, waysides, and recreational reserves; creating new state parks; authorizing additions to existing state parks, waysides, and recreational reserves; establishing and clarifying the boundaries of Jay Cooke state park.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **[85.1871] State parks; establishment of new parks and additions to existing parks, 1967. [Subdivision 1.] Split Rock Lighthouse state park.** Subdivision 1. The commissioner of administration for the commissioner of conservation, is authorized to acquire by gift or purchase, the following described lands in Lake county:

All of government lots 1 and 2, the south half of the southwest quarter, the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter, and the north half of the southeast quarter of section 32; all of government lot 3 of section 33; all in township 55 north, range 8 west of the 4th P.M. All of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter and government lots 1 and 3, all that part of government lot 2 lying outside of the existing statutory boundary of Split Rock state wayside, all in section 5; all of government lots 1, 2 and 3, the northeast quarter, the north half of the southwest quarter, and the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter, all in section 6; all of government lots 1 and 2 of section 7; all in township 54 north, range 8 west of the 4th P.M.

Subd. 2. The lands acquired pursuant to subdivision 1, together with lands presently constituting Split Rock state scenic wayside, comprise Split Rock Lighthouse state park which is hereby established under the supervision and control of the commissioner of conservation. The lands shall be administered in the same manner as provided for other state parks and shall be perpetually dedicated for such use.

Subd. 3. The revisor of statutes is directed to correct the next edition of Minnesota Statutes as follows to conform to subdi-

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vision 2: Whenever the statutes refer to "Split Rock State Scenic Wayside" he shall correct the wording to read "Split Rock Light-house state park"; and whenever the statutes refer to "state wayside" in connection with Split Rock State Scenic Wayside, he shall correct the wording to read "state park".

**Sec. 2. [Subd. 2.] Hayes Lake State Park.** Subdivision 1. Hayes Lake State Park is established in Roseau county.

Subd. 2. The commissioner of administration for the commissioner of conservation is authorized to acquire by gift or purchase, the following described lands in Roseau county:

All of sections 33 and 34; the south half of the southwest quarter and the south half of the southeast quarter of section 28; the northeast quarter, the north half of the southeast quarter, and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 32; all being in township 160 north, range 38 west of the 5th P.M. Also all of the north half of the northwest quarter and the north half of the northeast quarter of section 4; the east half, the east half of the northwest quarter, the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter, and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 3; the west half of section 2; the east half of the northeast quarter, the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter, and the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 11; the west half of the northwest quarter of section 12; all being in township 159 north, range 38 west of the 5th P.M.

The lands so acquired shall be administered in the same manner as provided for other state parks and shall be perpetually dedicated for such use.

**Sec. 3. [Subd. 3.] Additions to the state parks, waysides and recreational reserves.** Subdivision 1. **Acquisition of lands.** The lands described in this section are added to the boundaries of the designated state parks, waysides, and recreational reserves, and the commissioner of administration for the commissioner of conservation is authorized to acquire by gift, purchase, or, if expressly provided for by law by condemnation proceeding, the lands so described. In the case of additions herein described to the state parks described in Laws 1967, Chapter 100, the lands included in such additions may be acquired by eminent domain proceedings, subject to the conditions set forth in the said Laws 1967, Chapter 100.

Subd. 2. **Banning state park, Pine county.** All of government lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 of section 3; all of government lots 1 and 2 of section 10; all of government lots 1, 2, and 8, and

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all that part of government lots 3, 6, and 7 lying westerly of the westerly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 35 of section 11; all in township 43 north, range 20 west of the 4th P.M.

Also all of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter and the east half of the southwest quarter of section 15; all of the east half of the northwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 22; all in township 42 north, range 20 west of the 4th P.M.

Subd. 3. Beaver Creek Valley state park, Houston county. All that part of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 9 lying outside of the existing statutory boundary of Beaver Creek Valley state park; all that part of the north half of the northwest quarter of section 16 lying southerly of the said existing statutory boundary and north of the following described lines: Beginning at a point on the east line of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 16, 420 feet north of the southeast corner of said northeast quarter of the northwest quarter, thence northwesterly in a straight line to a point on the west line of said northeast quarter of the northwest quarter distance 1,020 feet north of the southwest corner of said northeast quarter of the northwest quarter, thence westerly in a straight line to a point on the west line of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter distance 1,150 feet north of the southwest corner of the said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter and there terminating; all in township 102 north, range 6 west of the 5th P.M.

Subd. 4. Buffalo River state park, Clay county. All that part of the east half of the southwest quarter, the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter, and the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter lying outside of the existing statutory boundary of Buffalo River state park; all that part of the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter lying southerly of a line 50 feet south of the southerly right-of-way line of the Northern Pacific Railroad; all in section 10. All that part of the south half of the northwest quarter lying southerly of the southerly right-of-way line of said railroad except the east 500 feet; all of the north half of the southwest quarter except the east 500 feet; all in section 11. All of the north half of the northeast quarter and all that part of the north half of the northwest quarter of section 14 lying outside of the said existing statutory boundary. All that part of the north half of section 15 lying outside of the said existing statutory boundary. All being in township 139 north, range 46 west of the 5th P.M.

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Subd. 5. Camden state park, Lyon county. All of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter and all that part of the west half of the southwest quarter of section 5 lying outside of existing statutory boundary of Camden state park; all that part of the west half of the northwest quarter of section 8 lying outside of the said statutory boundary; all that part of the east half of the southwest quarter of section 17 lying outside of the said statutory boundary except the right-of-way of the Great Northern Railroad; all being in township 110 north, range 42 west of the 5th P.M.

Subd. 6. Charles A. Lindbergh state park, Morrison county. All of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section 25; the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the west half of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 24; all being in township 129 north, range 30 west of the 5th P.M.

Subd. 7. Father Hennepin state memorial wayside park, Mille Lacs county. All of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 3, township 42 north, range 25 west of the 4th P.M.

Subd. 8. Gooseberry Falls state park, Lake county. All those parts of sections 21 and 22 lying outside of the existing statutory boundary of Gooseberry Falls state park. Also all of government lot 2 of section 27 and all of the north half of the northeast quarter and the north half of the northwest quarter of section 28; all being in township 54 north, range 9 west of the 4th P.M.

Subd. 9. Helmer Myre state park, Freeborn county. All that part of government lot 1 and the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 14, township 102 north, range 21 west of the 5th P.M. lying easterly of the easterly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 35.

Subd. 10. Lake Bronson state park, Kittson county. All of the south half of the northwest quarter and all that part of government lots 3 and 4 lying outside of the statutory boundary of Lake Bronson state park; all being in section 5, township 160 north, range 46 west of the 5th P.M. All of the west half of section 26, and all of the east half of section 27; all in township 161 north, range 46 west of the 5th P.M.

Subd. 11. Lake Carlos state park, Douglas county. All that part of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 15, township 129 north, range 37 west of the 5th P.M. lying

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outside of the existing statutory boundary of Lake Carlos state park.

Subd. 12. Lake Louise state park, Mower county. All that part of the west half of the northeast quarter of section 21, township 101 north, range 14 west of the 5th P.M. lying outside of the existing statutory boundary of Lake Louise state park. Also all that part of outlot 1 of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section 28, township 101 north, range 14 west of the 5th P.M. lying outside of the existing statutory boundary of said park.

Subd. 13. Lake Shetek state park, Murray county. All of government lot 6 of section 12, township 107 north, range 41 west of the 5th P.M.

Subd. 14. Little Elbow Lake state park, Mahnomen county. All that part of section 34, township 143 north, range 39 west of the 5th P.M. lying south of Minnesota Highway 113 conveyed to the state of Minnesota, department of highways, as a roadside parking area.

Subd. 15. Minneopa state park, Blue Earth county. All of government lot 7, the south half of the southeast quarter, the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, and all that part of the east half of the southwest quarter lying northerly of Minnesota Highway 68, all in section 7; all that part of section 8 lying southerly of the Minnesota River; all that part of the northeast quarter of section 18 lying northerly of Minnesota Highway 68 and outside of the existing statutory boundary of Minneopa state park; all that part of section 17 lying southernly of the Minnesota River and lying northerly of Minnesota Highway 68; all of government lot 5, all that part of government lots 6 and 7 lying northerly and westerly of Minneopa Creek; all that part of the west half of the southwest quarter lying northerly of Minnesota Highway 68 and westerly of Minneopa Creek, all that part of the east 620 feet of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter lying southerly of Minneopa Creek, all of the south 486 feet except the east 620 feet of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter, all that part of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter lying northerly of Minnesota Highway 68 and southwesterly of Minneopa Creek, all that part of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter lying southerly of Minnesota Highway 68 and westerly of County Road 129, all in section 16; all of the east 660 feet of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter lying northerly of Old U.S. Highway 169; all that part of the east

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*half of the northwest quarter and the west half of the northeast quarter lying northerly of the northerly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 169 and southerly of old U.S. Highway 169, all in section 20; all that part of the east half of the northwest quarter of section 21 lying northerly of the northerly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 169 and westerly of County Road 129; all being in township 108 north, range 27 west of the 5th P.M.*

Subd. 16. Rice Lake state park, Steele and Dodge counties. All of the north 20 acres of government lot 1; all that part of the north half of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter and the west half of the southeast quarter lying west of the township road; all being in section 6, township 107 north, range 18 west of the 5 P.M. All that part of the east 30 acres of government lot 1 of section 7, township 107 north, range 18 west of the 5th P.M. lying westerly of a line 840 feet west of the east line of said government lot 1.

Subd. 17. Savanna Portage state park, Aitkin and St. Louis counties. All of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 24, township 50 north, range 23 west of the 5th P.M.

Subd. 18. Sibley state park, Kandiyohi county. All that part of government lots 2 and 3 of section 2 lying outside of the existing statutory boundary of Sibley state park; all of government lot 1 of section 11; government lot 1 and the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 12; all being in township 121 north, range 35 west of the 5th P.M.

Subd. 19. Whitewater state park, Winona county. All of the east half of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 16, township 107 north, range 10 west of the 5th P.M.

Subd. 20. Ray Berglund state scenic memorial wayside, Cook county. All of lots 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of re-arrangement of government lot 1 of section 12 according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the register of deeds in and for Cook county; and all of the easterly one-half of the northerly 1,000 feet of government lot 2 of section 12; all in township 59 north, range 4 west of the 4th P.M.

Subd. 21. Lac qui Parle state recreation reserve, Lac qui Parle county. All of lot 13 of subplot 26 of government lot 2 of section 10; all that part of sections 14, 15, 23 and 24 lying

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between C.S.A.H. 33 as relocated in 1966 and the existing statutory boundary of Lac qui Parle state park.

Subd. 22. Fort Snelling State Historical Park, Ramsey, Dakota and Hennepin Counties. Lot 1 except the northerly 10 feet, Lots 2 and 3 except the northerly 20 feet, and Lots 4 and 5 except the railroad right of way, Block 2, Dakota County; the westerly 56 feet of Lot 6, Block 2; Lot 6 except the westerly 56 feet thereof, and the westerly 20 feet of vacated "E" Street adjacent thereto; Lot 7, Block 2, Lot 8, Block 2; Lot 9, Block 2; Lot 10 except the northerly 80½ feet thereof, Block 2; northerly 80½ feet of Lot 10, Block 2; Lots 55 through 99, Beaudette's Addition to the Town of Mendota, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated, but excepting railroad right of way and subject to Trunk Highway 13; Lots 47 through 54, Beaudette's Addition, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated or to be vacated, but excepting railroad right of way, and subject to State Trunk Highway 13; Lot 46, Beaudette's Addition, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated or to be vacated, but excepting railroad right of way, and subject to State Trunk Highway 13; Blocks 79 and 80, Sibley's First Addition to Mendota, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated or to be vacated, but excepting railroad right of way, and subject to State Trunk Highway 13; Block 11, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated or to be vacated, but excepting railroad right of way, and subject to State Trunk Highway 13; Block 5, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated or to be vacated, but excepting railroad right of way, and subject to State Trunk Highway 13; Block 4, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated or to be vacated, but excepting railroad right of way, and subject to State Trunk Highway 13; East 50 feet of Lot 2 and all of Lots 3, 4 and 5, Block 3, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated or to be vacated, but excepting railroad right of way, and subject to Trunk Highway 13; Lot 1, and all of Lot 2 except the east 50 feet thereof, Block 3, including any portion of any street or alley adjacent thereto, vacated or to be vacated, but excepting railroad right of way, and subject to State Trunk Highway 13; East half of vacated "E" Street; Lot 2, Section 27.

Sec. 4. [Subd. 4.] **Jay Cooke state park.** Notwithstanding any other law, Jay Cooke state park, heretofore established, shall consist of the following described lands, and the com-

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missioner of administration for the commissioner of conservation is authorized to acquire by gift or purchase, lands within these described lands not acquired by the state on the effective date of this act:

In township 48 north, range 15 west of the 4th P.M., Carlton county: All of government lots 5 and 6 of section 6. All of the west half of sections 7, 18, 19 and 30.

In township 48 north, range 16 west of the 4th P.M., Carlton county: All of sections 1, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 24 and 25. All that part of section 2 lying southerly and easterly of the Northern Pacific Railway. All of the southeast quarter and all that part of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 3 lying southerly and easterly of the Northern Pacific Railway. All of the northeast quarter of section 7. All of government lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7; the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter, the north half of the southwest quarter, and the south half of the southeast quarter of section 8. All of the unplatted portion of government lot 1 and all that part of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter lying easterly of the Great Northern Railway. Also in section 8.

All of section 9 except the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter and also excepting that part of the north half of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter lying south of the southerly boundary of the Northern Pacific Railway right-of-way and westerly of a line parallel with and 930 feet west of the easterly boundary of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter. All of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter and all that part of the north half and the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter lying northerly and easterly of the Great Northern Railway in section 17. All of the east half and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter and all that part of the northwest quarter and the north half of the southwest quarter lying northerly and easterly of the Great Northern Railway in section 21. All of the north half, the north half of the southwest quarter and the north half of the southeast quarter of section 22. All that part of sections 23 and 26 lying northerly and easterly of the Great Northern Railway.

The lands described in this section shall be administered in the same manner as provided for other state parks and shall be perpetually dedicated for such use.

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## CHAPTER 788—H. F. No. 1430

*An act relating to securities; exempting securities listed on the Pacific Coast Stock Exchange from registration; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 80.05, Subdivision 5.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 80.05, Subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. **Securities; Pacific Coast Stock Exchange.** Securities listed on the New York Stock Exchange, American Stock Exchange, *Pacific Coast Stock Exchange*, and Midwest Stock Exchange, and additional amounts of any such securities when regularly approved for listing upon notice of issuance thereof, which securities have been so listed pursuant to official authorization by such exchange, and all securities senior to any securities so listed, subscription rights so listed, or evidences of indebtedness guaranteed by companies any stock of which is so listed, such securities to be exempt only so long as such listing shall remain in effect.

## CHAPTER 789—H. F. No. 1457

*An act relating to the State Agricultural Society; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 37.23.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 37.23, is amended to read:

**37.23 State fair; justice of peace; justice court held on fair grounds.** The board of managers of the society shall annually designate a justice of the peace of Ramsey county, who shall hold his court within the limits of the fair grounds while the annual state fair is being held, and for one week prior and subsequent thereto,

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
