An act relating to school districts; election of the school board of Independent School District No. 535 at Rochester, following its conversion from a special district.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Independent school district No. 535; board. Section 1. because of proceedings taken under the provisions of Laws 1967. Chapter 833, the former Special School District No. 4 at Rochester has been converted to an independent district and is identified presently as Independent School District No. 535, the district shall continue to be governed by the same board until the qualification of members of the school board elected at the 1969 annual election for the independent district, at which election seven board members shall be elected, three for a one-year term, two for a two-year term, and two for a three-year term, and all shall continue in office until successors are elected and qualified. Before the election of the new board, the school board may divide the school district into election districts, each consisting of convenient and adjacent territory containing a number of residents as nearly equal as practicable to the number of residents in each of the other election districts, in which case one school board member and all his successors shall be elected by the residents in each election district, and if less than seven election districts are established, the remaining members of the school board shall be elected by the residents of the school district at large, and the school board shall designate the length of the term of each member to be elected initially.
- Sec. 2. Within three months after the filing of each subsequent federal decennial census with the secretary of state, under Minnesota Statutes, Section 600.18, and within three months after the effective date of any change in the boundaries of the district by reorganization, consolidation, attachment or otherwise, the school board shall reapportion the election districts, or confirm its previous apportionment, in such manner as will make the territory of each election district convenient, adjacent, and contiguous and otherwise in conformance to the requirements stated herein.
- Sec. 3. In the event that the school district is not divided into election districts in this manner, the school board members shall be elected at large, until and unless election districts are established in the manner provided by this act.

CHAPTER 194—S. F. No. 1385

An act relating to the city of Thief River Falls; authorizing the issuance of parking lot and park bonds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. Thief River Falls, city of; parks and parking. The city council of the city of Thief River Falls is authorized to issue bonds of the city in an amount not exceeding \$30,000 for the purpose of improving municipal parking lots and providing public rest room and shower facilities in a municipal park, such bonds to be payable from the net revenues derived from its municipal liquor store. The city council may also pledge the city's full faith, credit and taxing powers to make good any actual or anticipated deficiency in such revenues for the payment of principal and interest as they come due.
- This act takes effect when approved by the governing body of the city of Thief River Falls and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
